Comments
The strength of this course is that it taught me undergraduate level econometrics and made me more acquainted with econometrics research.
I thought that the course certainly helped me understand econometrics and economics in general more. It also helped me understand how to properly write economic literature which i believe is important. The only thing I think that could be improved is the clarity of what is expected. I think some confusion was due to the cengage portal and its assignments.
The course covered a wide variety of topics and there were natural connections between them. Overall, well organized and comprehensive course.
Unfortunately, I cannot speak about this course in a traditional sense due to its online format, but I feel confident that I learned the skills necessary to produce econometric research.
As someone interested in writing a thesis, this course gave me a fundamental undersatnding in data and empirical analysis.
I thought the course itself was relatively basic in material. It felt as though we did not cover very much material throughout the semester, and the assignments did not really help in cementing knowledge.
The course followed the textbook, which had a logical progression. I do wish we could have covered more of the textbook, but I completely understand and support the decision to go a bit slower based on the circumstances of the semester.
Good content, strong teaching
I liked that there were both qualitative, quantitative, and math interpretations of concepts. There were not consistent homework/due dates which made it hard to get into a rhythm, and made the latter part of the class much more work intensive.
The course focused on the most important topics in Econometrics instead of large amount of subjects. This allowed for us to truly understand and grasp the fundamentals of Econometric Analysis. This was much more helpful than scrambling to learn too many things without mastery of anything.


Comments


Comments












